What is the Fireline Ultrasonic Cleaning System: - The Fireline Ultrasonic Contents Cleaning System is an assembly line process to quickly and effectively clean customer's contents following damage caused by fire, smoke, water, mould or other related disasters. Ultrasonic cleaning is a technology that uses high frequency sound waves (ultrasonic: above the range of human hearing), creating a jet of liquid that in turn acts on contaminants adhering to contents and forces it off to rest at the bottom of the ultrasonic dipping tank. The principle behind ultrasonic cleaning is a phenomenon known as "cavitation".

What items can be cleaned in the Fireline Ultrasonic Cleaning System: - dishes/china, bake ware, cookware, jewellery, crystal, antiques, and collectibles.

The Fireline System: - The Fireline's systematic approach to contents restoration has emerged as the industry model and continues to set the standard for efficiency. The Fireline System works on the same basis as an assembly line. First your contents are brought to our facility. We then unwrap each box one at a time and place the items into baskets. Each basket is color tagged with that box to insure their contents are put back into their proper boxes at the end of the process. Once the contents are placed in the baskets they are placed into our pre-wash tank to remove all the loose soils. They are then moved to the ultrasonic tank where the remainder of the soils are removed. Once all the soils are removed, the contents are then moved to our rinse and detail station where the contents are rinsed off and inspected to insure the cleaning is complete. After the inspection, the contents are moved through the tunnel dryer. The final step is rewrapping and packing of your contents. They are then placed into their proper boxes to be returned to your home.

What is the Fireline Electronics Restoration System: - The Fireline Electronics Restoration System is a two part process in which electronics are taken apart and cleaned inside and outside with pressurized de-ionized water and detergent. The electronics are then placed in the Fireline Electronics dryer/deodorizer chamber for eight to ten hours in which the moisture is removed from the electronics and completely dried out. The electronics are then re-assembled. Even heavily contaminated electronics can be successfully restored to "pre-loss" or like new condition using this technology.

What items can be cleaned in the Electronics Cleaning System: - electronic toys, lamps, toasters, air conditioners, computers, monitors and keyboards, televisions and DVS players, phones.
